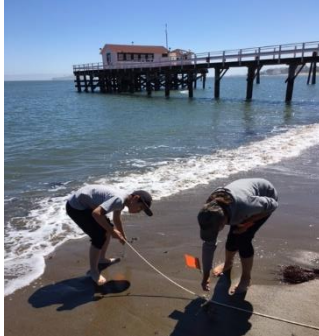




Farallones Spring Camp

March 28th – 30th, 2018



The Farallones Spring Camp will engage your child in active marine science learning during their Spring Break. Our focus for this camp will be Marine Ecosystem Science! Our intrepid campers will explore the diversity of our local ecosystems and real techniques for how scientists study organisms. We will culminate camp with a kayaking trip in Half Moon Bay!

Wednesday, March 28th – Sandy Beach and SF Bay

On our first day, we will explore the tiny world of plankton right from our pier in SF Bay and learn how they settle to become crabs, anemones, mussels, sea urchins and more! In the afternoon, our campers will engage in real scientific monitoring techniques to count and measure sand crabs on Crissy Field Beach.

Thursday, March 29th – Rocky Intertidal Zone

The morning of our second day we'll discover the adaptations of crabs through a scientific investigation, a crab dress-up and crab fishing (catch and release) from our pier. In the afternoon, we'll trek to the coast for an exciting tidepool exploration and scavenger hunt!

Friday, March 30th – Open Water

The morning of our final day consists of one of our favorite field trips – a fun, safe kayaking trip in Half-Moon Bay Harbor! In the afternoon we'll head back to Crissy Field and seek out seabirds and marine mammals with binoculars and field guides while hiking on the beach.
